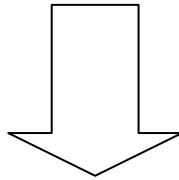


TRAVEL TIME RUNS AND FIELD LOG.

1. In order to accurately separate the GPS data into individual runs, it is important to keep an accurate and complete Field Log. To more closely match the satellite time, run start/stop times should be recorded using a cell phone (not a watch or vehicle clock). Data recorded on the log includes Run # (1,2,3,...); Run Direction (NB,SB,..); Start Time / End Time (14:40 – 14:45) and any notes that may be helpful for analysis (fire truck delayed traffic).
2. Data collection should begin and end when the vehicle is parked in a safe environment, i.e. a parking lot near the start of the first run. It is not necessary to turn the camera off or to stop recording between runs, however, you must come to a complete stop for 1 minute between the end of a run and the beginning of the next run. Do not make U-turns to start and end runs or there will not be a clear division between the runs.
